The operation began with a single truck and driver who mainly assisted with west coast trips. By 1987, the operation had expanded to six trucks with eight full-time and two part-time drivers. Round-trips to California took only six days. Ford Meter Box trucks have always been known for their cleanliness, friendly drivers, and carefully packaged product. By 1988, Ford trucks had traveled over one million miles to efficiently deliver Ford products to customers across the United States. Since then, fleet management has evolved with insurance and nexus constraints, but our drivers still serve as ambassadors in the field.

Today, Ford Meter Box continues to contract fleet services to supplement our shipping requirements, and we always enjoy hearing from our Ford family when they spot one of our logoed semis driving down the highway.
