

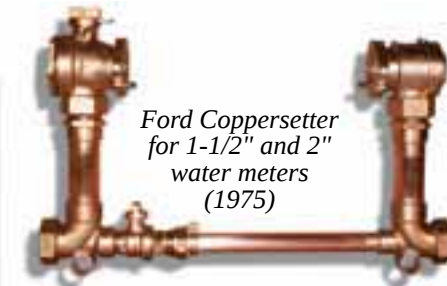

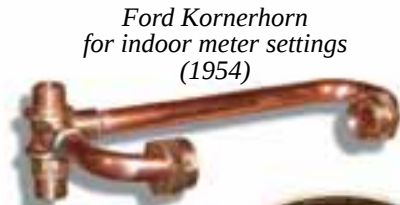
Ford Meter Setter Line: Evolution And Growth Over 110 Years



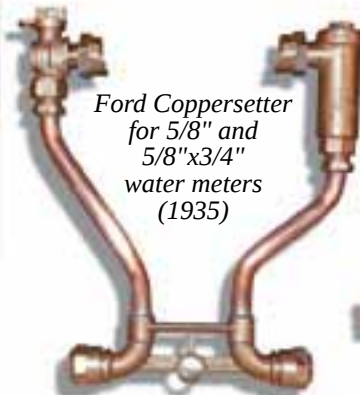
*Edwin Ford's

(1890s)*



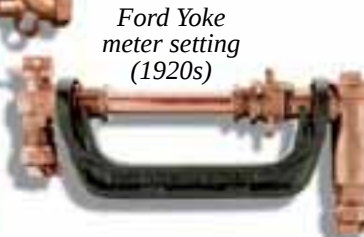
*Ford Coppersetter
