FORD ADAPTERS PROVIDE VERSATILITY WHEN METERING

Do you know of subdivision projects where developers incorporated large water lines to serve large homes and large lot sizes? These larger service lines and meter installations, in hindsight, may not prove necessary for every home. So how do you leave your metering options open without spending a lot of extra money? The answer: Ford meter adapters.

Ford Meter Box meter adapters offer the flexibility to change spud or flange sizes or meter

For example, Ford A46 adapters will allow a 1" meter to fit on a 1-1/2" meter setting. Later, if a 1-1/2" meter is ever needed, the adapters can be removed to install the larger meter.

lengths without a change to current plumbing.

Ford adapters also allow an easy retro-fit if a meter changeout uses a smaller meter.

For example, if the initially installed meter was too large, Ford A24 adapters allow a 5/8"x3/4" meter to fit in a 1" meter setting. Just screw the smaller end of the A24 adapter onto the 5/8"x3/4" meter and then the large end onto the existing 1" meter nut.

Ford Meter Box manufactures meter adapters using waterworks brass that conforms to AWWA standard C800 (ASTM B584, UNS C89833). Each design is tested and proven, featuring large wrench flats

and heavy-duty construction. Ford Catalog Section H contains a list of adapters designed to convert many different meters as well as a large selection of meter tailpieces and other meter-related items.
