Water Operator Competitions - ACE17

The AWWA Annual Conference and Exposition (ACE) provides an opportunity for water professionals to meet, learn, and discuss the world of water. Along with association committee meetings and training sessions, ACE offers an opportunity for fun. Six competitions are featured at ACE and five of them involve water operators.

AWWA operator competitions are:

- PIPE TAPPING Pipe Tapping is a competition of skill in which water operators work against the clock to drill a pressurized water pipe and install a service line connection. There are two divisions, Men's and Women's.
- THE WORLD WATER CUP The World Water Cup is an international tapping competition among champion teams from North America, the United Kingdom, and the Netherlands.
- TOP OPS Top Ops is the "college bowl" of the water industry. Teams of water operators and lab personnel compete against each other in a question-and-answer tournament.
- METER MADNESS Meter Madness is a fast-paced event where contestants assemble a
 water meter in the best possible time. The assembled meter is checked and tested to ensure
 proper operation.
- HYDRANT HYSTERIA Hydrant Hysteria features two-member teams working to assemble
 a hydrant as quickly as possible. Once assembled, the hydrant is checked by judges and
 penalties are assessed for a variety of errors including loose bolts and improper operation.
