


FORD ADAPTERS PROVIDE FLEXIBILITY WHEN METERING

Have you known a developer who submits his plans for a new subdivision that includes large homes, large lots, and large waterlines? Typically the service line does not really need to be that large, and you don't want to set the larger meter. How do you leave your options open without spending a lot of extra money? The answer is Ford meter adapters.

The Ford Meter Box Company offers meter adapters that can

increase spud or flange sizes and meter lengths to fit a larger meter setting, without changing the plumbing.

For example, Ford A46 adapters will allow 1" meters to fit 1-1/2" meter settings. Then, if ever a 1-1/2" meter is needed, just remove the adapters and install the larger meter.

Ford adapters also allow for the reverse situation. For example, the initially installed meter was too large. Ford A24 adapters allow 5/8"x3/4" meters to fit 1" meter settings. Just screw the smaller ends of the A24 adapters to the 5/8"x3/4" meter and then the large ends to the existing 1" meter nuts.

Ford Meter Box manufactures all of its meter adapters using 85-5-5-5 waterworks brass. Each design is tested and proven, featuring large square

wrench flats and heavy-duty construction. Ford Catalog Section H contains a list of adapters designed to convert many different meters as well as a large selection of meter tailpieces and other meter related items.
