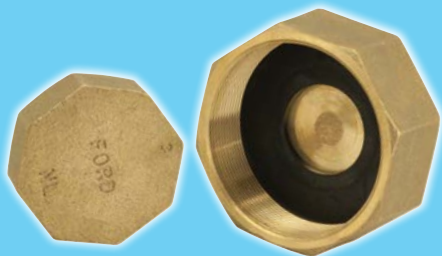
A Wide Variety of Options

During the 1950s, Ford Meter Box evolved from a “specialty house” to a manufacturer offering a wide variety of standard products. In 1956, design for a Ford Corporation Stop was completed and in 1957, field testing was well under way. By the 1970s, Ford introduced the Ford Ballcorp Corporation Stop, further expanding the Ford waterworks line of brass products. After decades of customer requests, Ford now offers many options for corporation stops that meet the needs of water utilities.

Some of these options include:

Brass End Caps

- Effectively seal off water flow and protect the brass threads
- Available for 3/4" - 2" valves and couplings



Tee-Head Adapters

- Facilitate easy valve operation
- Available for 1-1/4" - 2" Ballcorp Corporation Stops
- Add “-TA” to the catalog number to include a Tee-Head Adapter on a valve



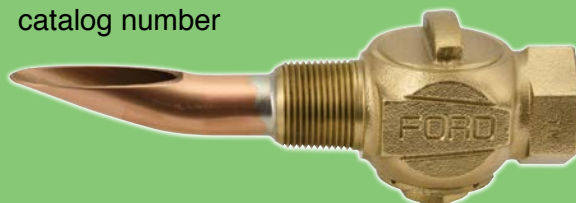
Tracer Wire Option

- Allows installation of a tracer wire to assist in locating plastic water lines underground
- Available on 3/4" - 2" CTS Quick Joint nuts
- To order, add “-TW-Q” to the catalog number



Pitorifice Option

- Helps prevent service line freezing
- Available for 3/4" or 1" Key Corporation Stops
- To order, add “-P” to the catalog number



Thaw Wire Option

- Allows attachment of a thawing wire as a solution for frozen service lines
- Available for 3/4" and 1" Quick Joint and Flare Copper Tube Nuts
- Has a lug attachment for connecting an electric thawing wire used by thawing machines with thermal overload protection
- To order, add “-THW” to the catalog number
