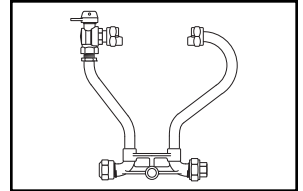


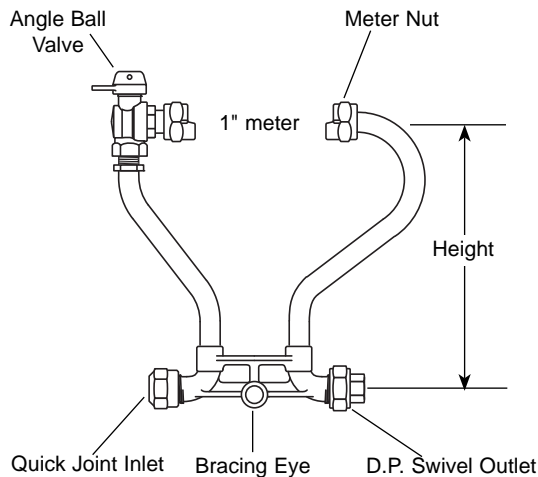

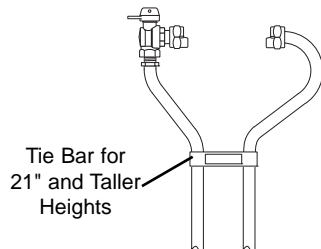
ANGLE BALL VALVE BY METER NUT (1" METER)
